Colonel Michael J. Remualdo is the vice commander of the 927th Air Refueling Wing, MacDill Air Force Base, Fla. He is responsible for the wartime readiness of Operations, Maintenance and Support Groups including two Medical units and directs staff in strategic planning/execution of policies and procedures ensuring resources are effectively employed.

Colonel Remualdo graduated from the U.S. Air Force Academy in 1992 with military honors. After graduation, he attended Undergraduate Pilot Training at Reese AFB, TX, the USAF's Rotary Wing Qualification Course at Ft. Rucker, AL and subsequently qualified in the HH-60G at Kirtland AFB, NM. His operational assignments in the H-60 included the 56th Rescue Squadron, Keflavik NAS, Iceland; the 66th Rescue Squadron, Nellis AFB, NV; and the 512th Rescue Squadron, Kirtland AFB, NM as a school house instructor pilot. He deployed several times in support of operations NORTHERN WATCH and SOUTHERN WATCH. Additional duties included Chief of Plans & Exercises, Squadron Safety Officer, Wing



Stan/Eval, Chief of Wing Testing, Chief of Squadron Stan/Eval, and Squadron Executive Officer.

As a USAF Reservist, Colonel Remualdo has flown the KC-135R and deployed several times in support of operations DELIBERATE FORGE, IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM, and UNIFIED PROTECTOR. Prior to his current position, he was the Commander, 730th Air Mobility Training Squadron, Altus AFB Oklahoma. He had full responsibility for the administration, supervision and training of all assigned Reserve personnel that provide formal training for both the KC-135 and C-17 aircrews.

He is a command pilot, with more than 5,200 hours which include over 800 combat and combat support hours. He is also a commercial airline pilot with over 4,200 hours.
